- Access to Prior Learning Assessment and Recognition (PLAR)
- The opportunity to earn high school credits towards your Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD)

You must be:

- At least 18 years of age
- Proficient in English (Canadian Language Benchmark Level 5 completed or higher)
- Resident of Ontario
- Legally entitled to study and work in Canada
- Committed to attend classes and work on a full-time basis for 26 weeks
